

## Call for Applications

# CARE Collaboration Trainee Research Exchange

The CARE Collaboration is providing funding for three international exchanges for graduate student and postdoctoral trainees to build caregiver sensitivity and child attachment research capacity. Participants will visit a host institution for a minimum of one month, up to three months, contributing to the CARE Collaboration's mission to bridge research to practice gaps. Successful applicants will receive up to \$8,000 CAD in expense reimbursement.

### Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

- Be a CARE Collaboration member committed to bridging research to practice gaps in caregiver sensitivity and child attachment.
- Be enrolled in or affiliated with an accredited institution at the Master's, PhD, or Postdoctoral level.
- Independently identify a host institution and supervisor by the time of application submission.

### Program Benefits

Participants will have the opportunity to:

- Work with leading researchers in the field.
- Access unique resources and research facilities within the CARE Collaboration network.
- Engage in cross-cultural interdisciplinary collaboration.
- Contribute to joint publications and explore opportunities for future collaborations.

### Application Requirements

Applicants must submit the following materials in one single file by **March 31, 2025** by [applying here](#).

- A proposal including objectives, methodology, expected outcomes, budget, and timeline (max 1200 words).
- A letter of motivation outlining the applicant's interest in the exchange and how it aligns with their academic and professional goals (max 600 words).
- A CV and academic transcripts.
- Reference letters from two referees.
- Letter of support from the exchange host supervisor.
